CLUB ACTIVITIES & RULES

CLUB HOURS: 1100 – 2400, Tuesday to Sunday. Closed on Mondays.

GUESTS:

Guests are welcome at all times (except at Club meetings) but must be signed in by a member who will be responsible for their conduct. Guests are to leave when the member leaves. Do not sign in someone you do not know. To avoid identification confusion by the Stewards, please accompany your guest to the bar when ordering drinks and set an example by **RETURNING BOTTLES & GLASSES** to the bar each time you re-order and when you leave the Club

NEW MEMBERS:

Only **_NAVAL** members are allowed to sponsor new applicants. Naval members, please ensure that you know the applicant before you PRINT your name and number on the application form.

APPLICATIONS:

Applicants are not automatically accepted by the Membership Committee. There are priorities and limitations laid down by the Naval Club's Constitution and by the Executive Committee.

GENERAL MEETINGS:

The Club is managed and controlled by an elected Executive. The Constitution calls for bi-monthly meetings which are normally held on the third Sunday of January, March, May, July, September and November (AGM) commencing at 1330. **NO GUESTS** are permitted.

WHISKERS CLUB:

This is a Club within the Club. Whiskers is open to male members and their male guest only and is held on the second Tuesday of every month. For a \$15.00 entry fee you receive one drink and a delicious meal along with comradeship and fun. The basic annual fee is \$25.00 and is payable on the month of your birthday. The Christmas Dinner (December) is free providing that you have attended a minimum of three dinner meetings throughout the year and have paid your annual fee.

WORK PARTIES:

The Club requires a good deal of maintenance to uphold our housekeeping standards. If you have any special skills or you are just a handy, willing worker, please contact the House Director or any member of the Executive.

SHIP'S BELL:

BEWARE! Any member or their guest who rings the Bell, buys a round for the House. It is a serious offence to ring the Bell unless you fully intend to buy drinks for the House. If you wish to buy drinks, please forewarn the Steward so that he/she is prepared for the rush at the bar.

EUCHRE:

House League Euchre is played every second Saturday commencing at 1330. Guests are welcome.

BRIDGE:

House League Contract Bridge is played on alternate Saturdays commencing at 1330. Guests are welcome.

DRESS CODE:

Although there is not normally a strict dress code in the Club, members and their guests are expected to be appropriately dressed for the occasion. Shirts/tops must be worn at all times. Cut-offs are not permitted nor T-shirts with inappropriate slogans. Track pants are discouraged in the evenings. On certain occasions – Battle of Atlantic, Remembrance Day, etc. – Strict Dress Code is in effect. Blues and Greys, Uniform or Business Attire only, permitted.

HEAD GEAR:

Male members and their guests (unless restricted for religious purposes) must remove their head gear before entering the Club. Failure to do so will result in buying a round for the House.
